Homework 9 - Menus

Setup a custom Run-Time Menu with the following items in the order given below:

File Application - only include New..., Open..., Close, Print Window, and Exit.

Edit Application - only include Undo, Redo, Cut, Copy, Paste, and Clear.

SELECT a Date - this will be user defined. Through this menu option, you will select a day, month, and year between 2000 and 2010.

Help Application - include the entire menu

- Your VI should only have on the front panel a power switch to turn the VI off. Using the examples discussed in class, edit the run-time menu and design your VI so that it does the following:
- When the SELECT a DATE menu item is chosen, change the menu label to read "Select Year".
- When the user chooses "Select Year", the submenu is changed so that the user chooses a year from the menu between 2000 and 2001.
- After a year is chosen, change the main label menu to read "Select Month". When the user chooses "Select Month", the submenu has been changed so that the user selects a month (January through December) from the menu.
- After the Month is chosen, have a message pop-up in the VI with the month and year chosen by the user. After the user closes the message box, return the main menu section back to "SELECT a DATE" so that the VI can be run again.

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
