Visiting the UMDNJ Medical Library (George F. Smith Library)

Take the CHEN shuttle.

Ask driver to leave you off at the Medical Science Building (#11 on the UMDNJ Campus Map)
Walk initially to your right and then head left around the large Medical Science Bldg back towards the library

Library => site #12 on Map, where there are steps that go up underneath the overhanging building directly to the library entrance. Show your NJIT ID badge to the guard for entrance. Continue past the circulation desk into the main lobby of the library, and look for the Reference Desk. The reference desk is manned between 9 am – 5 pm during the week. The library itself is open longer hours: 8 am – 11 pm M-Th, 8 am – 10 pm M-Fr, 8 am – 9 pm Sunday (closed Sat).
