1. Use the method of reduction of order to find a second independent solution of the equation

$$t^2y'' + 3ty' + y = 0, \quad t > 0; \quad y_1(t) = t^{-1}.$$

2. Find the solution of the IVP:

$$y'' + 4y = 3 \sin 2t, \quad y(0) = 2, \quad y'(0) = -1.$$

Solution : Problem 1: $y_2 = v(t)y_1, \quad y_2' = v'y_1 + vy_1', \quad y_2'' = v''y_1 + 2v'y_1' + vy_1''$

$$t^2(v''y_1 + 2v'y_1' + vy_1'') + 3t(v'y_1 + vy_1') + vy_1 = 0$$

$$(t^2y_1)'' + (2t^2y_1' + 3ty_1)v' = 0, \quad tv'' + v' = 0, \quad \frac{v''}{v'} = -\frac{1}{t},$$

$$\ln v' = -\ln t = \ln \frac{1}{t}, \quad v' = \frac{1}{t}, \quad v = \ln t, \quad \boxed{y_2 = t^{\ln t}}$$

Problem 2: $y'' + 4y = 3 \sin 2t, \quad y(0) = 2, \quad y'(0) = -1$

$$y_c \Rightarrow y_c'' + 4y_c = 0, \quad r^2 + 4 = 0, \quad r = \pm 2i, \quad y_c = C_1 \cos 2t + C_2 \sin 2t$$

$$Y = t(A \cos 2t + B \sin 2t)$$

$$Y' = A \cos 2t + B \sin 2t + 2t(-A \sin 2t + B \cos 2t)$$

$$Y'' = -2A \sin 2t + 2B \cos 2t + 2(-A \sin 2t + B \cos 2t) + 4t(-A \cos 2t - B \sin 2t)$$

$$Y'' + 4Y = 4t(-A \cos 2t - B \sin 2t) - 4A \sin 2t + 4B \cos 2t \\ + 4t(A \cos 2t + B \sin 2t) = 3 \sin 2t,$$

$$-4A = 3, \quad 4B = 0 \Rightarrow A = -\frac{3}{4}, \quad B = 0$$

$$y = C_1 \cos 2t + C_2 \sin 2t - \frac{3}{4}t \cos 2t \quad y(0) = 2 = C_1$$

$$y' = -2C_1 \sin 2t + 2C_2 \cos 2t - \frac{3}{4}(0) \cos 2t + \frac{3}{2}t \sin 2t \quad y'(0) = -1 = -2C_1 \cdot 0 + 2 \cdot C_2 - \frac{3}{4}$$

$$2C_2 - \frac{3}{4} = -1, \quad 2C_2 = -\frac{1}{4}, \quad C_2 = -\frac{1}{8}$$

$$\boxed{y = 2 \cos 2t - \frac{1}{8} \sin 2t - \frac{3}{4}t \cos 2t}$$

$$C_2 = -\frac{1}{8}$$
