Internet2 is a bigger, stronger, and faster version of today's Internet. Designed for research, Internet2 allows for multi-point video conferencing, remote instrumentation, large database sharing, and advanced distance collaboration.

Internet2 will enhance teaching, learning, research and help establish timely communication between academic institutions.

It is a day designed to increase faculty awareness of the capabilities of Internet2 and to showcase some ways it is already being used by educational institutions across the United States.
